Membership:

The membership fee of \$40.00 per month for the Jambalaya Cooperative Gallery entitles the member to following:

- Space to display, sell and store art work
- A place to meet and collaborate with other artists
- Studio space for an additional nominal fee

Membership fees are due the 1st of each month:

Membership fees are due the first of each month. If the membership fee is not paid for two consecutive months, without prior arrangement, all remaining artwork on the premises must be removed and the key returned within one month, to the President or Treasurer. If said artwork is not removed within one month, it becomes the property of Jambalaya Cooperative Gallery. Your membership fee goes toward the rent and utilities of the Jambalaya Cooperative Gallery building.

Member Responsibilities:

- Put up and take down of art work is to be completed no later than Friday evening prior to the monthly Gallery Walks or the evening prior to any show the Jambalaya Cooperative Gallery puts on (i.e. juried exhibitions).
- Provide refreshments, or collaborate with other members to help provide refreshments for Gallery Walks and other shows as needed.
- Clean up after yourself, as well as volunteer for improvement projects.
